Summer Programme 2009

Sudan Volunteer Programme is looking for volunteers to join the new Summer Programme to begin in Khartoum towards the end of June, ending mid August.

The work is the teaching of conversational English to university students and graduates who need the language for their professional and business life.

Sudan is one of the friendliest and safest countries: the tragedies of the recent war in the south and conflict of Darfur have not affected the excellent personal security in Khartoum and the outlying northern towns where SVP works. SVP has experience of 12 years of operation and has volunteers in Sudan all year round. Our volunteers are welcome and their work is recognized to be urgently required. Orientation and training is provided on arrival.

Candidates should be at least past their second year at university, be native English speakers (nationality or country of origin are not a problem) and be able to raise money to pay for their flight to Khartoum - about £405 - or less on the web and their contribution to SVP's group travel insurance - about £45.

Experience of foreign travel and its discomforts are advantages. TEFL or Arabic are very welcome but not required. Accommodation and modest stipend will be paid by SVP. Successful candidates will need a statement of fitness from their GP.

SVP also needs longer term volunteers who can start late September and can offer 8 months or more in Sudan.
